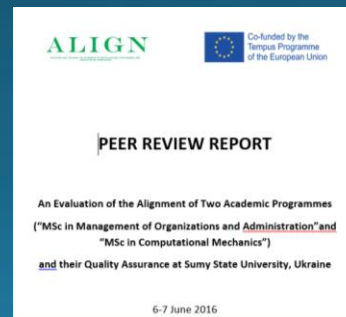

Kostyantyn Kyrychenko presented the HEI's experience in the implementation of large-scale grant programmes of the European Union, their impact on the development and internationalization of universities and the prospects for expansion of international cooperation within new programme Erasmus+.

The event was dedicated to the results and achievements of Erasmus Mundus international grant programme, and also the prospects of Erasmus+ programme. Internationalization of higher education, recognition of studies and impact of mobility on skills and career development were discussed during the conference.

100 participants from 50 countries (among them there're 15 countries of the European Union) took part at the conference.






The effective engagement with student representatives

- Review of Representation Policy and place a stronger emphasis on student representation systems for students
- In partnership with students, formalize the review and monitoring of student representation at all levels of the University governance structure
- Development of the mechanism for the engagement of students and postgraduates in the working design teams, in particular, the formation of a representative selection approach
- Review the terms of reference for the Student Affairs Group to further strengthen collaborative working
- Further development of the internal quality system of the university by identifying a number of targeted joint initiatives
- A joint approach to the development and implementation of an action plan to improve the quality policy of the university and the development of curricula
- Review and enhance the training provided to all student representatives


Attracting external stakeholders to programme design and approval

- Discussion of the results of the analysis at the meetings of the Quality Assurance Councils of the faculties (institutes) and the University Quality Board
- Development of a regulatory base related to participation of external stakeholders in the internal quality assurance system.
- Development of an Action Plan for the certification of practice bases and potential employer partners in order to create employers' databases in the graduating departments
- Development of surveys of graduates and employers on the design of new competitive academic programs and improvement of existing ones
- Development of the software module "Integration with personnel customers and graduates" in the "University" system for improving cooperation with external stakeholders as well as with internal stakeholders and the ability to create databases for graduates and employers

Students' assessment, recognition and certification



Development of the University's Guide to Assessment, Standards, Marking and Feedback gives clear and extensive advice on how various forms of assessment can be used to demonstrate the achievement of learning outcomes. The framework for programme design also clearly indicates the need to link assessment with learning outcomes. Programme specifications are expected to explain the link between learning outcomes and assessment.



New edition of the Regulation on the organization of the educational process in relation to the enrollment, achievement, recognition and certification of students (definition of rules for recognition of previous learning outcomes, competences acquired through academic mobility, additional, formal and non-formal learning, peculiarities of certification for students with disabilities)

Development of educational resources and student support

Implementation of the mechanism and organizational support of tutoring and counseling for higher education graduates (including persons with disabilities) throughout the entire period of study

University adopted a standardised format for programme handbooks consisting of programme-specific information in Part A and generic material, such as University policies and regulations, in Part B.

Design of the handbook for each academic program according to the template (information in Part A)

Developing a questionnaire and conducting a survey of students regarding their level of satisfaction with the quality of educational resources and support for higher education applicants

Ensuring information transparency of the university and academic programs

- Formation of a list of compulsory elements of public information on academic programs to be published on the websites of institutes (faculties)

- Providing technical support for placement of information about academic programs

- Publication of information on academic programs on the web-sites of institutes (faculties)

- Placement in open access (on the web-sites of departments) information about the activities of teachers

- Development of the information model of the university, the structure of informational content that will be oriented as external information consumers (entrants, applicants of higher education, graduates, other stakeholders and the public), and will provide an opportunity for the development of information blocks for licensing and accreditation of academic programs according to the updated rules and criteria

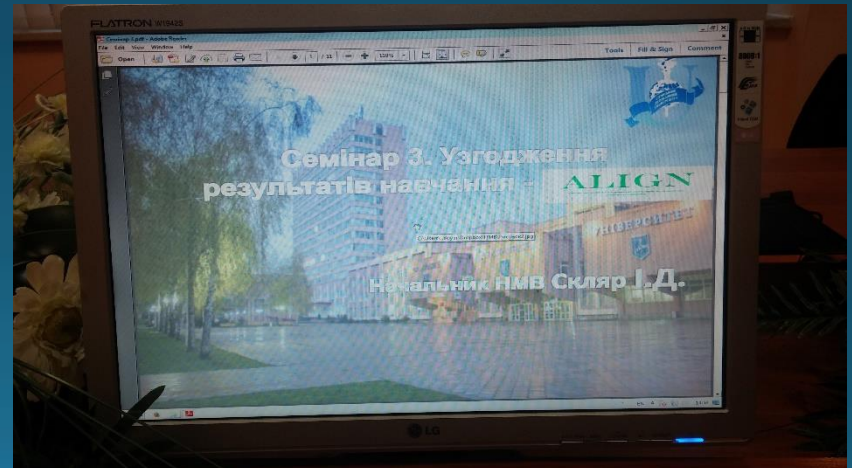
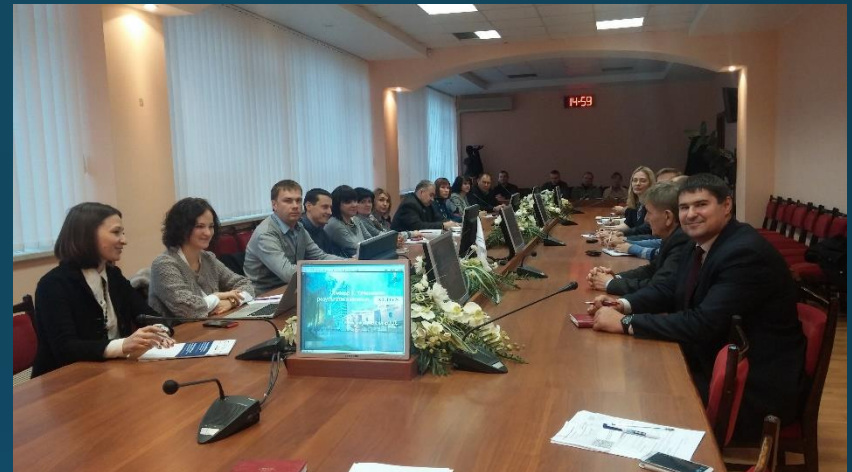

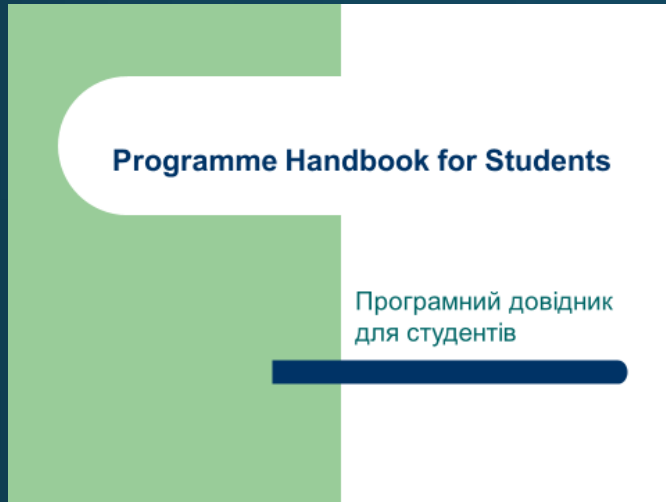
